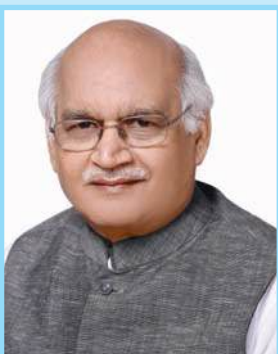

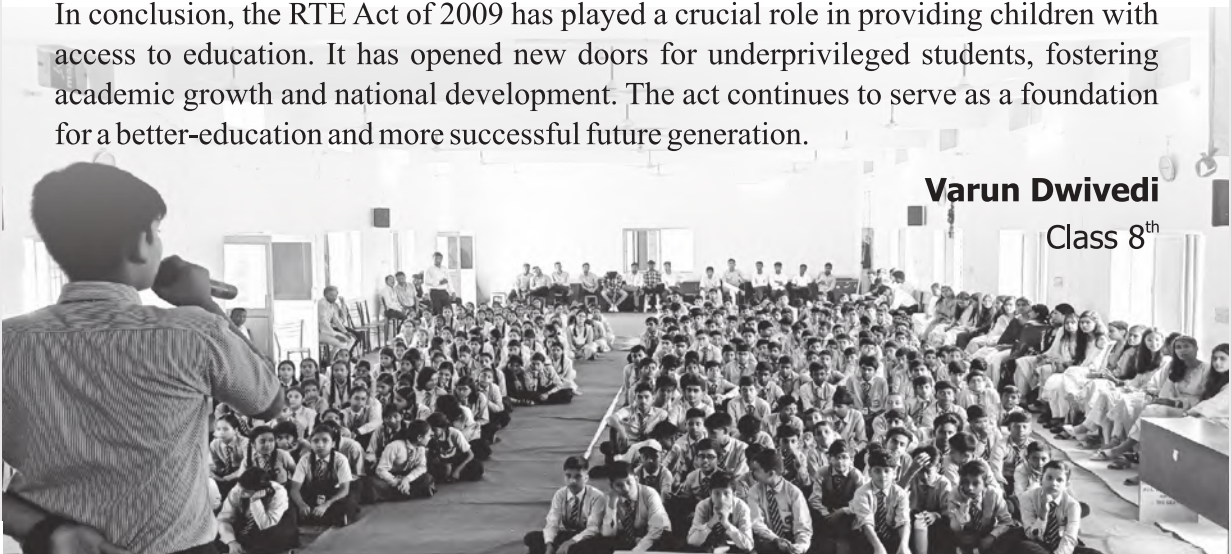

अब विद्यार्थियों को जाति, धर्म, क्षेत्रवाद से ऊपर उठकर समय और परिस्थितियों के अनुसार चलना होगा। विद्यार्थियों को अपने व्यक्तिगत विकास को संतुलित करते हुए अपने दृष्टिकोण को विस्तृत करना चाहिए। उन्हें बुराइयों को नजरअंदाज करना चाहिए और अच्छाइयों को स्वीकार करना चाहिए। यही एक विद्यार्थी का कर्तव्य होना चाहिए।

किसी भी राष्ट्र की उन्नति उसी समय हो सकती है जब देश के विद्यार्थी बिना किसी भेदभाव के अपने कर्तव्यों का पालन करें।

स्वामी विवेकानंद का परिचय

स्वामी विवेकानंद का जन्म 12 जनवरी 1863 को कलकत्ता (अब कोलकाता) में हुआ था और उनका निधन 1902 में हुआ। उनका पूरा नाम नरेन्द्रनाथ दत्त था। उनके पिता का नाम विश्वनाथ दत्त और माता का नाम भुवनेश्वरी देवी था। वे एक महान विचारक, शिक्षाविद, मार्गदर्शक और प्रभावशाली वक्ता थे।

कन्याकुमारी की घटना: वे तीन दिनों तक समुद्र के किनारे चट्टानों पर ध्यानमग्न होकर बैठे। यह स्थान तमिलनाडु के कन्याकुमारी में स्थित है। उन्होंने वहां गहराई से चिंतन किया और आत्मज्ञान की प्राप्ति की। वे लंबे समय तक ध्यान केंद्रित कर सकते थे।

उनके जीवन में शिक्षा की भूमिका: स्वामी विवेकानंद एक प्रबुद्ध विचारक थे। उनके लिए ज्ञान प्राप्ति सर्वोच्च उद्देश्य था। उनकी सफलता में उनकी माता का भी महत्वपूर्ण योगदान था, जिन्होंने उन्हें सदैव अच्छे संस्कार और विचार दिए।

शिकागो भाषण: स्वामी विवेकानंद का शिकागो भाषण हमारे देश के लिए गौरवपूर्ण क्षण था। यह भाषण 1893 में यूरोप में हुआ था और इसे अत्यधिक लोकप्रियता मिली। इस भाषण ने भारत की सांस्कृतिक और आध्यात्मिक पहचान को अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मंच पर स्थापित किया।

आध्यात्मिक ज्ञान का अर्थ: स्वामी विवेकानंद के अनुसार, आध्यात्मिक ज्ञान का अर्थ है कि ज्ञान की शक्ति। उन्होंने केवल ज्ञान के बल पर ख्याति प्राप्त की, न कि धन या किसी पृष्ठभूमि के बल पर।

शिक्षा के प्रति समर्पण: स्वामी विवेकानंद और उनके गुरु दोनों शिक्षा के प्रचार-प्रसार के लिए विशेष रूप से महिलाओं की शिक्षा के लिए समर्पित थे। उन्होंने शिक्षा के महत्व को जन-जन तक पहुँचाने के लिए उपदेश दिए।

राष्ट्रीय युवा दिवस: स्वामी विवेकानंद की जयंती 12 जनवरी को राष्ट्रीय युवा दिवस के रूप में मनाई जाती है।

प्रेरणास्पद पंक्ति: “उठो, जागो, लक्ष्य पर ध्यान दो और विचारों को जन्म दो चिंता मत करो, चिंतन करो।”

डॉ. सर्वपल्ली राधाकृष्णन

विषय: डॉ. सर्वपल्ली राधाकृष्णन का भारत के प्रति योगदान

परिचय: डॉ. सर्वपल्ली राधाकृष्णन का जन्म 5 सितंबर 1888 को तमिलनाडु में हुआ था। वे एक महान दार्शनिक और शिक्षाविद थे। उन्होंने भारत के पहले उपराष्ट्रपति के रूप में 1952 से सेवा दी। वे शिक्षा प्रणाली को आकार देने में अग्रणी रहे। उन्होंने शिक्षा के प्रति गहरा समर्पण दिखाया, और इसी कारणवश उनके जन्मदिवस को भारत में शिक्षक दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है।

मुख्य विषय: शिक्षक समाज के स्तंभ होते हैं। वे अपने ज्ञान से समाज के भविष्य को आकार देते हैं। स्वयं एक योग्य शिक्षक होने के नाते, डॉ. राधाकृष्णन ने नैतिक और चारित्र मूल्यों के महत्व को प्रतिपादित किया। उनके विचार आज भी नई पीढ़ियों को प्रेरित करते हैं। उन्होंने अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर भी पहचान प्राप्त की और अपने कई कार्यों से भारत का नाम रोशन किया।

डॉ. राधाकृष्णन के विचार:

उनके कुछ प्रसिद्ध विचारों में यह शामिल है: “आनंद और खुशी का जीवन, ज्ञान और विज्ञान पर आधारित होता है।”

वे मानते थे कि शिक्षा केवल ज्ञान प्रदान करने तक सीमित नहीं होनी चाहिए, बल्कि उसमें नैतिक मूल्यों को भी समाहित होना चाहिए। उनका जन्मदिन हर वर्ष 5 सितंबर को शिक्षक दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है, ताकि उनके योगदान को सम्मानित किया जा सके।

निष्कर्ष: डॉ. राधाकृष्णन से प्रेरणा लेते हुए, आज भी अनेकों विद्यार्थी शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में उत्कृष्ट कार्य कर रहे हैं। वे शिक्षक, दार्शनिक और समाज के लिए प्रेरणा स्रोत थे। उन्हें भारत रत्न से भी सम्मानित किया गया था। “जो पुस्तकें हम पढ़ते हैं, वही समाज में पुल का निर्माण करती हैं।” शिक्षा हर व्यक्ति के लिए अत्यंत आवश्यक है, और डॉ. राधाकृष्णन जैसे महान शिक्षक हमें यह सिखाते हैं कि ज्ञान, नैतिकता और सेवा से ही समाज का विकास संभव है। शिक्षक दिवस की हार्दिक शुभकामनाएं।

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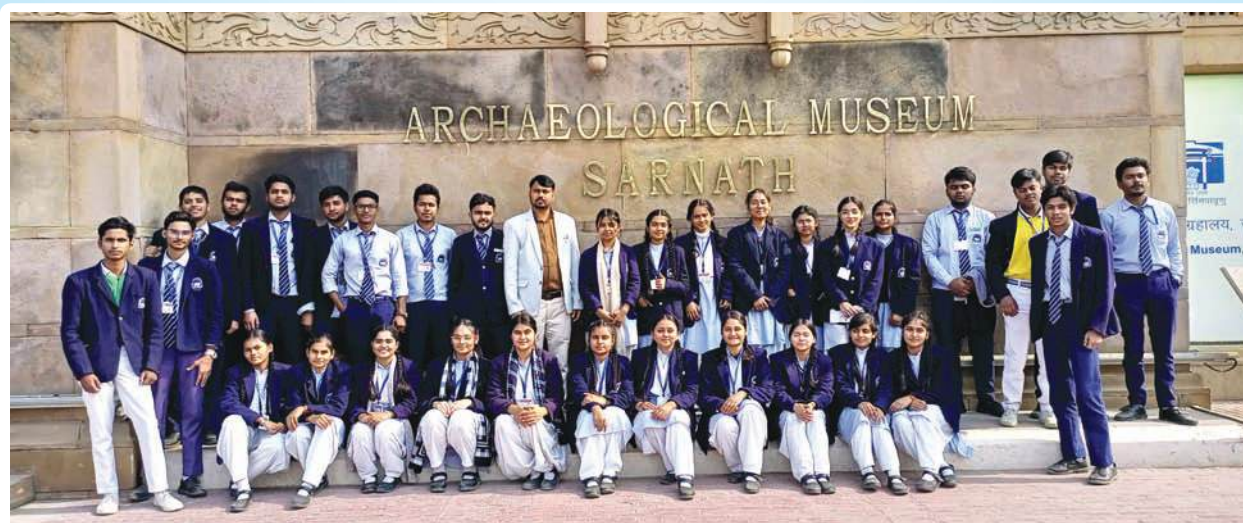
